



## **Disclaimer for Access to the Stakeholders Update Call**

Connection to the Stakeholders Update Call ("Stakeholders Update Call") and the acknowledgment of the documents and information discussed therein (the "Confidential Information") are subject to the full acceptance of this disclaimer. All material available within the Update Call is strictly confidential and intended exclusively for the purposes specifically authorized under the terms of this disclaimer.

By connecting to the Stakeholders Update Call, the user agrees to:

- Take all appropriate measures to ensure the confidentiality, security, and integrity of the Confidential Information discussed during the Stakeholders Update Call and to prevent its disclosure to third parties.
- Not disclose, transmit, copy, reproduce, or use the Confidential Information for purposes other than those strictly authorized.
- Limit access to the Confidential Information exclusively to individuals expressly authorized and bound by confidentiality obligations equivalent to those contained in this disclaimer.
- Destroy, within 5 (five) working days from the written request of the Company and at their own expense, any Confidential Information as well as all copies of such Confidential Information. The user also agrees to provide, at the time of such destruction, a written statement to the Company confirming that all received Confidential Information has been destroyed and that no Confidential Information remains in the possession of the user or the individuals expressly authorized to access it.

Each access is monitored and recorded. The user is fully responsible for the use of their account and for all activities carried out within the Stakeholders Update Call. The Company reserves the right to revoke or limit access at any time, at its discretion and without obligation of prior notice.

If the user is required to disclose the Confidential Information by law or by order of a judicial or administrative authority or by legislative or regulatory provisions, before proceeding with such disclosure, they must, to the extent permitted by applicable law:

- (a) Promptly inform the Company in writing of such a request.
- (b) Obtain the prior consent of the Company regarding the methods and content of such disclosure.
- (c) Transmit only the information strictly necessary to comply with the order.
- (d) Immediately take all necessary and appropriate measures or actions to protect the Confidential Information.



- (e) Ensure that the disclosed Confidential Information is treated with the highest degree of confidentiality.

Personal data, including those relating to criminal convictions and offenses pursuant to Article 10 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, processed during the Stakeholders Update Call, are made available to the user for purposes other than those for which they were originally collected, in order to ensure transparency in the Company's governance processes. In accordance with the current legislation on the protection of personal data, it is specified that such data are subject to confidentiality constraints and must be treated with the utmost diligence, in full compliance with the principles of lawfulness, fairness, transparency, relevance, and proportionality. Any unauthorized, improper, or non-compliant processing with the applicable legislation may result in liability, including compensation for any damage suffered, including non-material damage, by the data subjects or the data controller.

The provisions of this disclaimer are valid, regardless of the destruction of the Confidential Information or any copies thereof, for 3 (three) years from the acceptance of this disclaimer.

Violation of the above obligations may cause serious and irreparable damage to the Company. The user will therefore be required to indemnify and hold the Company harmless from any adverse consequences, including losses, charges, liabilities, and legal expenses, resulting from such violation. No provision of this disclaimer can be interpreted in such a way as to prevent the Company from taking any other action or claiming damages under any applicable law. The delayed or non-exercise of the rights provided by this disclaimer by the Company does not constitute a waiver of such rights.

Any dispute concerning the violation of the obligations set forth in this disclaimer is subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court of Milan.
